

What is LITE?

LITE stands for 'Live-In Theological Experience' and is a national ecumenical youth event. Its theme this year is the World Council of Churches' (WCC) 'Decade to Overcome Violence' (DOV). DOV was launched in 2001, in Germany, and the WCC hopes that churches and people everywhere will do what they can to help bring about a more peaceful world.

At LITE there will be speakers and lots of time for discussion; plus games, worship, abseiling (optional!), a workshop on learning inter-personal conflict resolution skills, free-time, a performance by Christchurch Playback Theatre Company, a party night and opportunities to think about how we can all make a difference.

LITE is being run by the Student Christian Movement of Aotearoa (SCMA) and Theology House, with sponsorship and support from the Conference of Churches in Aotearoa New Zealand (CCANZ).

SCMA is part of the world's oldest international ecumenical student organisation, the World Student Christian Federation (WSCF). SCM is active in over 90 countries and representatives from different SCM movements get together regularly for training programmes and meetings (see www.wscfap.org for Asia-Pacific region details). New Zealand currently has four local 'units' (in Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch and Dunedin) where members hold forums on a range of topics, have fun together and get involved in various social justice and peace issues.

Theology House is a Christchurch organisation, with Anglican roots, which offers a wide range of courses, workshops, conferences and resource material.

CCANZ (see www.ccanz.net.nz) is New Zealand's national ecumenical body. The ecumenical movement worldwide seeks to bring the churches together and make a positive difference in the world.

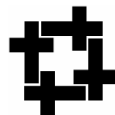
